New Vision Projects

Below are new projects and initiatives.

- *Big 4th Sunday:*

We are thrilled to announce our Big 4th Sundays, which include a special emphasis on evangelism. Our goal is to welcome **250 people** to the weekend services.

- *Campus Renovation Updates:*
 - o **Demolition of the White/Old Fellowship Hall Building:** We plan to demolish the old fellowship hall building to make way for new and improved facilities and parking. This is a significant step in our ongoing efforts to enhance our campus and prepare for growth.

Campus Renovations: We are excited to share the progress on our campus renovations, which aim to enhance our facilities for the benefit of our congregation and community.

- *Worship Center*
 - o We replaced the traditional pews with chairs to increase seating capacity and flexibility for various events.
 - o The nursery is operational providing a safe and welcoming space for our youngest members.

- *Education Building*
 - o Comprehensive mold remediation was completed to ensure a healthy environment.
 - o We are installing new drywall and will paint throughout the building.
 - o The children and youth areas are being retrofitted with new furniture and equipment to serve their needs better.
 - o Upgrades to the HVAC and plumbing system will be made to improve comfort and efficiency.
 - o Electrical work to ensure safety and meet our technological needs within the building.

- *Campus Exterior*
 - o The Flower Bed is being remodeled to create a welcoming atmosphere for the campus.

- The walkway to the worship center has been updated for better accessibility.
- New seating has been added to the lobby to allow comfortable gatherings before and after service.

Recent Outreach

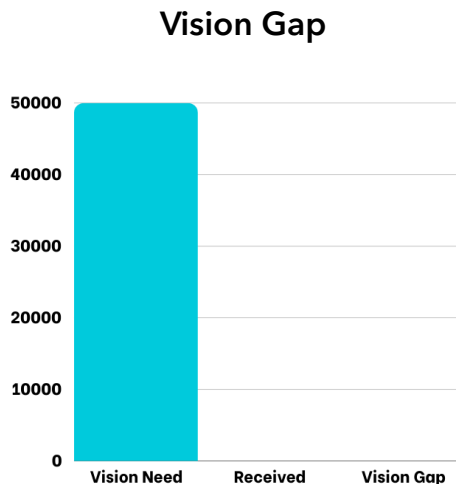
- **Middle School Lock In- July 26th**

Vision Gap



We're currently facing a **\$50,000 vision gap** that, if unmet, will delay the opening of our education facility in the first quarter. **On Trunk or Treat Sunday, our current kids' space was completely overwhelmed. Every room in the building, apart from staff offices, was used to serve our children, and each of those spaces were filled.** God is clearly blessing

Freedom Worship with growth, and we're in urgent need to complete renovations in our education facility to accommodate the growth.

This vision gap affects more than just our physical space. Without this funding, our kids' ministry, already at capacity, will be unable to expand, and our middle school ministry—so needed in our community—will face a delay in its launch. Plans for significant outreach through Big Evangelism days in the new year will also be impacted. This isn't simply about a building; it's about creating space for growth, connection, and transformation for the families and children we're called to serve.
